

The Economic Impact of Construction in the United States and

Economic Impact of Construction:

- x U.S. gross domestic product (GDR)e value of all goods and services produced in the country aled \$29 trillion at a seasonally adjusted annual rate in the Quarter of 202; construction contributed \$3.trillion (4.5%).
- x In lowa, construction contribute \$12 billion (4.8%) of the state's GDP \$256 billion.
- x Therewere 943,000 construction establishments in the U.S. in the fuarter of 2024 including 9,500 in lowa. (An establishment is a fixed business location; about 99% of construction firms have only one establishment.)

Construction Spending:

- x Nonresidential spending in the U.S. totaled \$1.1 trillion in 20**236\$** illion private, \$40 billion public).
