

The Economic Impact of Construction in the United States and Mississippi

Economic Impact of Construction:

- x U.S. gross domestic product (GDR) e value of all goods and services produced in the country aled \$29 trillion at a seasonally adjusted annual rate in the quarter of 2024; construction contributed \$3. trillion (4.5%).
- x In Mississippi construction contribute 66 billion (3.6%) of the state's GDP 6156 billion.
- x Therewere 943,000 constructionestablishments in the U.S. in the duarter of 2024 including 6,800 in Mississippi (An establishment is a fixed business location; about 99% of construction firms have only one establishment.)

Construction Spending:

- x Nonresidential spending in the U.S. totaled \$1.1 trillion in 20236\$ illion private, \$40 billion public).
- x Residential construction spending in the U.S. totaled 8980 in (\$400 billion singlefamily, \$136 billion multifamily, \$331 billion improvements, \$11 billion public).
- x Private nonresidential spending in Mississite table \$2 billion in 2023. State and local spending total \$4 billion. (Totals are not available for residential, railroad, power, communication, or federal construction of the table for table
